AWARD-NOMINATED ACCESS SOLUTIONS FOR THE VASE

PTSG (Integral Cradles) was shortlisted for its work at One Blackfriars, London.

Integral Cradles is PTSG Access & Safety Ltd's team based for the south of England. Its experts provide permanent façade access solutions for some of London's most iconic new skyscrapers including The Scalpel (52 Lime Street), The Gherkin (30 St Mary's Axe) and The Cheesegrater (the Leadenhall Building).

One Blackfriars, also known as The Vase, is a unique skyscraper inspired by a piece of 1950s Scandinavian art. When a unique access system was required, PTSG was contracted.

Its engineers installed three building maintenance units (BMUs) each weighing up to 40 tonnes and a telescopic reach up to 30 metres. On level 50, great innovation was employed to create a louvred roof system to hide the BMU from view.

During the project, the team collaborated closely with the client and supply chain, sharing 3D models to ensure each BMU was housed in the most space-efficient way possible. PTSG recorded 16,500 working hours on the project with no injuries.
