




PTSG and Aviva

PTSG's high-level engineers attended the site to remove a damage glazed unit and replace it, refitting pressure plates and capping. They used powered access to reach the building's atrium roof. They also used a mobile scaffold tower to access the glazed units from the ground and internally.

Q1 Building, Handyside Street, King's Cross

Designed by Coffey Architects, the Q1 office building in Handyside Street, King's Cross is a high-specification building that draws on the industrial heritage of the site. The façade is a silver perforated aluminium that sits well with the neighbouring buildings along York Way with the black and greys of the King's Cross Sports Hall and Arthouse.
