PTSG to work at new mixed-use scheme in Bromley



Premier Technical Services Group Ltd (PTSG) has been contracted by McLaren Construction to deliver specialist fire solutions at a new mixed use Public Private Partnership (PPP) scheme transforming part of Bromley town centre.

Known as St Mark's Square, it is designed to kick start the regeneration of the south end of Bromley.

At the heart of the new residential and leisure quarter sits a 53,000-square-feet landscaped public square surrounded by a 29,000-square-feet multiplex cinema, 28,000-square-feet of cafes and restaurants, a business hotel, private and affordable apartments, and a new secure space underground car park.

The residential element of the scheme is being built to Code for Sustainable Homes (CfSH) Level 4. Energy costs to residents will be reduced by 30% through better insulation, good ventilation and the provision of an onsite combined heat and power system. The remaining building elements deliver an 'Excellent' BREEAM rating.
